2019 SCHOLARSHIP AWARD (College-Post High School Level)**

Eligibility Criteria

- Must be enrolled (at the time of application and disbursement of scholarship) full-time at an accredited college or university and have completed 24 semester units of college study by March 15, 2019, (proof of registration and official transcript will be required prior to award disbursement)
- Must pursue a degree in criminal justice or related field and be committed to a career in criminal justice field
- Must have a minimum, cumulative grade point average of 3.0
- Must complete the application and submit required documents by March 15, 2019 (if using a postal delivery service, application must be postmarked by March 15, 2019). Late, incomplete and/or illegible application packets will not be reviewed/considered for awards

Application Process

1. Complete and submit NOBLE scholarship application package and all documents by March 15, 2019. Mail your completed application package to:

2. Submit a type-written, double-spaced, 12-point font, 650 - 750 word essay (one-inch margins) outlining your career goals; action(s) taken toward achieving your future goals; reasons why you should receive an award, and information identifying how this award might assist with achievement of your goals and giving back to your community. **You must author/prepare your own essay.**
3. Submit a copy of your current transcript as proof of your grade point average; an unofficial copy is acceptable at submission deadline.
4. Submit two (2) letters of recommendation in support of your application. Letters must be from a current/former faculty member, student support personnel, or a local community leader (recommendations from immediate or extended family members are not acceptable).
5. Submit a current, non-copyrighted photograph (a solo, head shot) for use in the event of selection. Photos will not be returned.

Evaluation Criteria

- Applicants will be evaluated based on academic achievements, community involvement, experience, extracurricular activities, personal recommendations, financial need and written essay.
- All applicants will be notified after final selections are made. The award recipient will be honored during the Western Region VI, Training Conference or local event.
